Hettie Theresa Milder Jedlicka was born on October 23, 1917 and went home to be with our Lord on October 18, 2011. She passed away peacefully while living at Fort Bend Nursing Home in Rosenberg, where she had many kind and loving caregivers.

Hettie was born in Theon and grew up in the Cornhill Community. After her marriage to Anton in 1945, they lived in many farming communities. Hettie was an active member in the Rosenberg American Legion Ladies Auxiliary, a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church and a long-time KJZT member.

Hettie was a great cook, a quilter and a wonderful kolache baker - especially cheese ones. The neighbor children would say that she was famous for her Popcorn balls at Halloween time. Mostly, Hettie was a homemaker and a gardener. She did not allow a weed to live long in that yard. She was a loving Mother, Grandma and Great Grandma.
