Hugo owned and operated City Drug Store in Needville for 58 years. Hugo was a member of Immanuel United Church of Christ in Needville. He was also a member of the Texas Pharmacy Association, life member of the University of Texas Ex-Student's Association, he was past President of the Needville Chamber of Commerce, he was Needville Youth Fair past President, Wharton County Junior College Board of Trustees member for 25 years and was veteran in the United States Air Force.
