August 5, 1916 - May 3, 2014

Ida Bockhorn Schulze, age 97, passed away in Wharton, Texas on May 3, 2014. Ida was born to Edward and Dorothea Meier Bockhorn in Needville, Texas, on August 5, 1916. She graduated from Richmond High School in 1934 and married Arthur D. Schulze in 1936. She raised three sons while supporting her husband in the radio, tv, and appliance business in Richmond Schulze Radio and later Schulze Appliance. She baked many special cakes for local friends and was a founding member and organist for Peace Lutheran Church in Rosenberg.
