Irma started her teaching career at Donna Independent School District. Beginning in 1982 at Stafford Municipal School District, Irma taught Special Education at the Elementary School and High School. In 1991, she taught First Grade Bilingual Students and received her 20 years of service

recognition from SMSD in 2003. Irma retired in 2008, achieving an accomplishment of 30 years of teaching.

Irma passed away on Thursday, July 9, 2020 in Sugar Land, Texas.

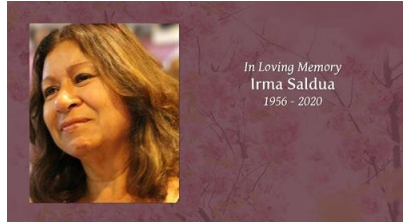
Irma is preceded in death by her parents, Justo and Agedita Torres; parents, Ignacio and Eustolia Barrerra; and first husband, Martin Saldua.
