sister, Cynthia Prest.

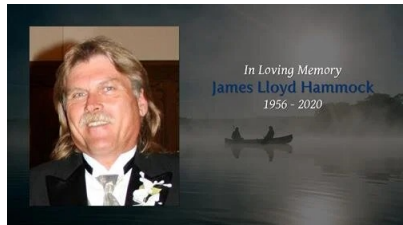
A celebration of life service will be held for immediate family only at Westside Church of the Nazarene in Katy, Texas on November 7, 2020.

The family would like to extend their sincere gratitude for all the thoughts and prayers over the last few years.

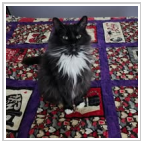
