



James Carl Hopkins Jr.

December 13, 1938 - October 9, 2023

James Carl Hopkins was born in Taylor, Texas, on December 13, 1938. The eldest of four in the James and Carla Hopkins' family, James Jr., who was also called Carl, spent his early years in Raccoon Bend and Bellville, graduating from Bellville High School in 1957. After serving in the U.S. Army, James returned to Bellville to marry his high school sweetheart and best friend, Gloria Stuessel. They made their home in Rosenberg, with James working at Reed Tool Company during the day and attending the University of Houston at night. He graduated with a degree in accounting and shortly thereafter became a Certified Public Accountant.

After his years with Reed Tool and Creole in Houston, James started a C.P.A. practice in Rosenberg. Together with Gloria, they worked nights and weekends from home, using the kitchen table as their office. Within a few years, the business was thriving. The firm continued to grow for over twenty-five years, with James providing tax services and consulting to businesses and families nationwide.

From an early age, James felt called to serve his community. He actively participated in the Rose-Rich Jaycees, Sons of Hermann, American Legion, and Rosenberg Brethren Church, and proudly served on a variety of boards and advisory councils, including Rosenberg City Council, where he dedicated himself to his constituents for over twenty years.

James retired to devote his attention to Gloria's care when she became ill. They were married for forty-nine years and six months, until her passing in 2010. During those years, the family expanded to welcome four grandchildren, and James went from "Dad" to "Dandy" (the name given to him by his grandson).

James was a voracious reader, loved puzzles, watching any sports game, working in his yard, barbecuing, playing dominos, and - most of all - spending time with his family.

James is survived by his daughter, Catherine Engelbrecht; son, James Hopkins and his

wife, Vy; grandchildren, William Engelbrecht, Elizabeth Engelbrecht, Catherine Reese Hopkins, Madeline Hopkins; Josephina Haro, who worked with the Hopkins family as a caregiver for over twenty years; and many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
