July 16, 1945 - September 2, 2012

A memorial service for James "Jim" David Tucker, 67, of Richmond, Texas will be held at 3:00 p.m., Friday, September 7, 2012 in the Chapel of Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Home in Rosenberg with Rev. Frankie Rodriguez officiating.

Jim was born July 16, 1945 in Iowa City, Iowa to John and Beulah Miller Tucker. He honorably served our country in the United States Navy. Jim was a member of the Richmond Rotary Club, the Elks Club of Iowa City, Iowa and the V.F. W. in Coralville, Iowa. Known as Grandpa Jim and Peaux Peaux to his grandchildren, Jim enjoyed cooking and traveling and liked to go fishing in northern Minnesota. He was the co-owner and operator of Plantation True Value Hardware in Richmond. He also co-founded and operated Kinderfarm Preschool in Iowa City, Iowa. He enjoyed playing golf whenever he was able and recently renewed his interest in art and photography. He passed away September 2, 2012 in Houston.

He is preceded in death by his parents, John and Beulah Tucker; and sister, Jacqueline Tucker Berridge Burns.
