James Richard Krueger, 89, passed away on March 4, 2021. He was born December 27, 1931 in Ithaca, Nebraska to John Gustav and Gladys Soland Krueger. Jim grew up on the family farm in Ithaca where a hard work ethic was instilled in him at a young age. As a young adult, Jim followed his sister, Donna Cruse, to Texas where he began a 35-1/2 year career as a master electrician with Houston Lighting and Power. 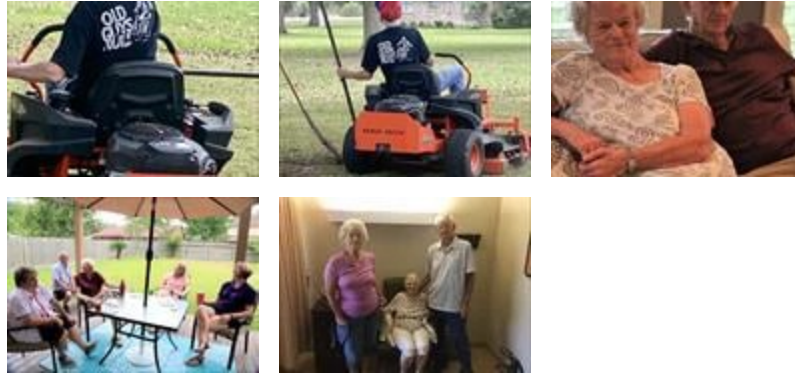

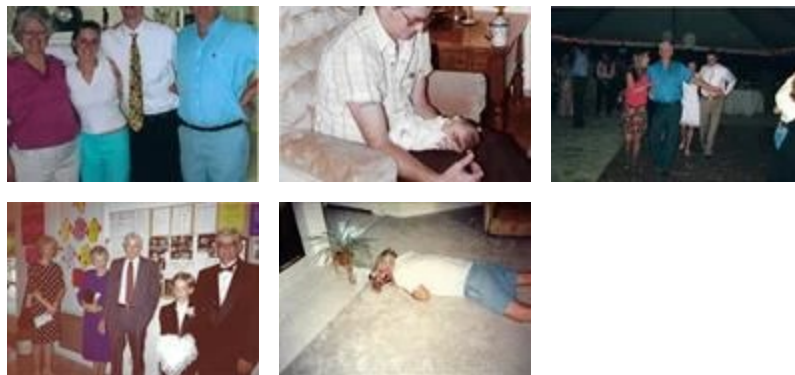

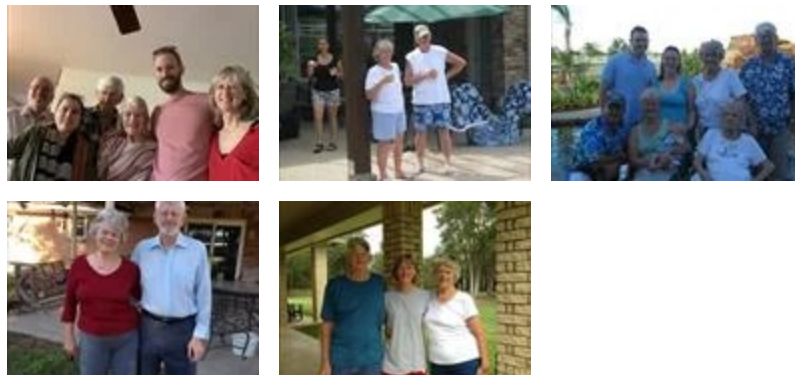
