Janie Oberhoff, Born February 2, 1930 in Sugar Land, Texas. Passed Away February 19, 2011 at 2:46 P.M. at Richmond Health Care Center where she was a patient for approximately 2 months. Janie was the daughter of Pete and Mary Olbrych Borowski. Janie graduated from Sugar Land High School in 1947. Shortly after graduation she began to work in Family Restaurants in the Sugar Land, Stafford, Rosenberg and Richmond area. Janie married Fritz Oberhoff on July 21, 1951 in Sugar Land. Fritz was in the Air Force and just arrived from a tour of duty for 32 months in Germany. He was in transit from New York to his new duty station at Hill Air Force Base in Ogden, Utah. She lived there until Fritz's discharge on November 11, 1953. After arriving back in Rosenberg where they made their home until her death.

Later she worked in grocery stores, mainly at Simmons Super Market. Then she went to work for First National Bank in Rosenberg, later Wells Fargo and retired after 26 years. She loved sports, volleyball, softball and some tennis.

She also loved going to her husband's deer lease in the hill country. Not much of a hunter, but enjoyed camp life. She was in charge of the kitchen. She helped the cook prepare 2 meals a day for some 12 years. There were 12 to 16 hunters to be fed, always smiling and carrying on with everyone. She also was quite a fisherwoman and enjoyed going to their cabin at Chinquepin East Matagorda Bay.

Survivors include her husband of 59 years, Fritz J. Oberhoff, 1 sister, Anna Pausewang of Sargent, 2 sister-in-laws, Evelyn Rhyner of Houston and Evelyn Oberhoff of Rosenberg and a number of nieces, nephews and many friends.
