Jerome "Jerry" Kulcak, 100, of Rosenberg, Texas passed away on January 12, 2024 surrounded by his family. He was born on February 19, 1923 in Fairchilds, Texas to Joseph and Lena (Chytka) Kulcak. Jerry honorably served our country in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He was a long-time member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg. Jerry held memberships in Knights of Columbus, KJT, American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and was a lifetime member of the Cotton Gin Association.

Jerry started farming for his Dad on an old log wheel tractor and continued when his Dad was unable to farm any longer. He and his brother, Alphonse, farmed together for many years. They were the first to own a modern cotton picker in Fort Bend County. Jerry also worked for Dow Chemical in Freeport for 36 years in the electrical field before retiring. In 1979 he was asked to manage the Fairchilds Farmers Gin and brought it up to modern standards. He also had a great love of investing in the stock market.

This loving father, Popo, uncle and friend will truly be missed.

In addition to his parents, Jerry is preceded in death by his wife, Emma Gurecky Kulcak; brother, Alphonse Kulcak; sister, Margaret Vallet; son-in-law, Peter Brysch and grandson, Chad Turman.
