



## Jerome E. Rainosek

September 10, 1921 - July 15, 2008

A Funeral Mass for Jerome E. Rainosek, 86, of Fairchilds, will be held at 10:00 A. M., Saturday, July 19, 2008 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Needville with Father Don Schwarting officiating. Interment will follow in Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.

Visitation will be held from 5:00 P. M. until 8:00 P. M., with a rosary being recited at 7:00 P. M., Friday, July 18, 2008 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Jerome was born September 10, 1921 in Bluff, Texas to Willie and Annie Rainosek of Houston, Texas. He was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church, KJT and American Legion Post #350 of Needville. He was a very proud American soldier with the 5th Armored Recon Division in WWII. After numerous near death experiences that took place in France and Germany, he was the only one of seven soldiers from his troop to make it home. Three weeks after returning home, he married the love of his life, Evelyn. He tried his green thumb in farming but then decided to become an Auto Mechanic. He was the owner and operator of Rainosek's Garage for many years. In his spare time he loved gardening and was an avid hunter who loved to make deer sausage with his sons. Jerome was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather to his wife and family. He will be greatly missed, but he leaves behind many fond memories that will be cherished. July 15, 2008 in Rosenberg, Texas.
