Jerry Sebesta, 67, of Rosenberg, Texas passed away surrounded by his family, Thursday, September 4, 2025. He was born October 6, 1957, at St. Joseph's Hospital in Houston, Texas to Frank and Leona (Tomczak) Sebesta. Jerry worked for Anderson Clayton Cottonseed Mill until 1983. From there Jerry went to work at W.A. Parish Power Plant in Thompson, Texas, ending his career as a Head Operator after 41 years of service.

Jerry loved hunting, fishing, golfing, poker, and playing pool. Mostly, he just loved being with family and friends. In February 2018, Jerry received the gift of a heart transplant at Methodist Hospital in Houston. Jerry was known for his huge heart and would offer help to anyone who needed it. He was loving, hardworking, stubborn, caring, compassionate, warmhearted, loyal, and had his own great sense of humor.

He was diagnosed with cancer in June 2025. He fought a hard fight, but his physical body was tired and couldn't keep up with the determination he had in his heart to keep going.
