August 29, 1930 - November 12, 2017

Jerry Lynn Suchma, Jr., 87, of Rosenberg, went home to be with the Lord on November 12, 2017. He was born August 29, 1930, the son of Jerry L. Suchma, Sr. and Willie Mae Walcik Suchma.

He graduated from Richmond High School on a Friday evening in 1948, being a member of the last graduating class before Richmond and Rosenberg consolidated. The following morning, he left for Navy boot camp where he went to Radio Operator School, specializing in both Morse code and voice. He was stationed on the USS Union AKA 106, a cargo and troop ship, and was discharged in 1950. His first job back home was with Texas Gulf Sulfur. His following work history included HL&P and Needville I.S.D. At the time of his passing, he was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg, and a resident of Cambridge Square Assisted Living, also in Rosenberg. He never met a stranger, and his smile always left a lasting impression on all.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Anita, along with his parents, sisters, brother, and countless other relatives/in-laws.

Survivors include his wife of 19 years, Helen Schultz of Rosenberg, sons and
