



Jimmy Allen Armstrong

January 3, 1941 - June 3, 2012

Funeral services for Jimmy Allen Armstrong, 71, of Guy, Texas will be held at 11 a.m., Thursday, June 7, 2012 at First Baptist Church in Damon. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg. Reverend Larry Grover will officiate the services.

Visitation will be from 5 p.m. until 8 p.m., Wednesday, June 6, 2012 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Jimmy was born January 3, 1941 in Bay City to Robert and Dorothy Burford Armstrong. He served our country in the United States Navy during Vietnam. Jimmy was a member of the V.F.W. Post #3903 and the D.A.V. Disabled American Veterans. Jimmy retired from Nalco Chemical Company in Sugar Land after many years. He enjoyed watching baseball, raising cattle, picking pecans, dewberries for jelly, cutting wood and spending time with family and friends. Jimmy was known as "Papa Jimmy" to his grandchildren. He passed away June 3, 2012.
