Jimmy Lee Green, 87, of Rosenberg, passed away on November 15, 2013. He was born on June 19, 1926, in Dayton, Texas, to William Hardy Green and Willie Thelma Short Green. He graduated from Barbers Hill High School in 1943. He was drafted into the United States Army in 1944 and served stateside during the end of World War II.
