John C. Cangelosi, Jr., 78, of Missouri City, Texas passed away on May 19, 2020. He was born on November 4, 1941 in Bryan, Texas to John C. Cangelosi Sr. and Anna Lee (Angonia) Cangelosi. He was a proud graduate of Dulles High School, The University of Houston and South Texas College of Law. He practiced law for over 45 years. He was the 1st Assistant District Attorney of Brazoria County, also serving Fort Bend, Wharton and Matagorda counties in 1973.
