John L. Moore, Sr., 82, of Rosenberg, Texas passed away on May 24, 2026. He was born on November 13, 1943 in Houston, Texas to Robert Thomas Moore and Mary J. (Howell) Moore. John graduated from Lamar Consolidated High School in 1962 and he honorably served our country in the U.S. Army from October of 1966 until April of 1967. He was employed by the Needville Police Department from 1987 – 1992 and then moved on to work as a Patrol Deputy for the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Department for 14 years from 1992 until his retirement in 2006.
