John L. Pavlock, 83, of Rosenberg, TX, passed away on December 22, 2021 after complications from a stroke.

John was born on September 16, 1938 in Beasley, TX to Tony and Verna Pavlock, who both preceded him in death.

After graduating from Lamar Consolidated High School, John went to work for the Texas Department of Transportation, where he worked for over 40 years until retirement.

He was also a proud 8 year member of the Texas National Guard.

In 1963 he met his future wife, Shirley, at a pick-up basketball game. Shirley was the love of his life, and John and Shirley were married in 1964 and soon after had 2 daughters, Natalie and Wendy. They were happily married for 57 years.

John was an avid sports fan. He loved all sports, but especially enjoyed watching college football. Playing dominos, bingo, and spending time with his family and friends were important to him. He also loved trips to Coushatta and playing Texas Hold'em.

John is survived by his wife Shirley Grigar Pavlock; daughter Natalie and her husband Greg Meadlin; daughter Wendy and her husband Pat Perry; and 5 grandchildren: Cole Meadlin, and Blake, Christopher, Emily and Annie Perry.

He will forever be in their hearts and missed dearly.
