Joyce Pesak was the youngest of 7 children born on November 8, 1933 at home to Adolph and Minnie Graeber on the Ellerman place in Needville, Fort Bend County, Texas.

She journeyed heaven homeward on October 16, 2024. Her aura was peaceful.

Joyce lived in Needville where she was active all of her life. She attended school at Jane Long in Richmond until the Needville High School was opened in 1948. Joyce along with her best friend, Sylvia Pesak, was a cheerleader there. She graduated from there in 1951.

Joyce married Charlie Pesak on November 18, 1951. They celebrated their wedding anniversary 63 times. They lived in Louisiana for a short time but moved back to Needville and made their permanent home there. Mom always had an extra plate for anyone who showed up around mealtime. She would put the coffee on and make everyone feel welcome for a visit.

After Linda started school, mom entered the outside workforce. She worked for the Richmond State School, moved on to Texas Instruments and settled down with Charlene Anderson making draperies.

Joyce was an active member of St. Paul's Presbyterian Church. She held

office with the United Presbyterian Women and was chair for one of the serving committees. She also served on session for the church. She helped serve for a few years at the Senior Citizen Site.

Until this past March, Joyce was always on the go and ready to help anyone she could.

Joyce is survived by her children, Evelyn Durlinger, David Pesak, Joan Horky and her husband Ray, Nancy Kopecky and her husband Matt, Marie Turner and her husband A. J. 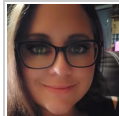
