Julio Becerra, died peacefully on Sunday, January 15, 2012 surrounded by his wife and loving family.

Visitation will be held at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church on Wednesday, January 18th from 5 – 8 p.m. with Rosary at 7:00 p.m. A funeral mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Rosenberg on Thursday, January the 19th at 1:00 p.m. Interment with military honors will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.

Julio was a strong source of faith and love to his wife and children, who adored and respected him always. He was a proud member of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Rosenberg, where he served our Lord as a Eucharistic Minister.

Julio was born in Needville, Texas on December 20, 1928 to Jose Joe and Severa Galvan Becerra. He grew up in Rosenberg, where he attended and graduated from Rosenberg High School, Class of 1948. He served in the U.S. Air Force, retiring from the U.S. Air Force Reserves as a Technical Sergeant. He married his soul mate, Mary Cantu, on September 11, 1949.
