He met his wife of 66 years, Juanita, while working for Sears in Dallas. Larry loved the ranching business, politics and community affairs. In 1998, he was named Honorary Mayor of Pecan Grove. Larry was so involved in the community that his name was even tagged on a chair at the Commissioners Court. He took pride in attending every session until his health prevented him from doing so. Larry also served as a Bailiff for the Grand Jury for many years. Larry was a member of Calvary Episcopal in Richmond for many years. He was also a Mason for 60 years and a Shriner. He passed away on June 20, 2007 in Richmond.

Larry is preceded in death by his parents, John and Jessie Hughes; brother, John Hughes and sister, Ruby Adams and her husband, Henry.
