Leland Schroeder passed away peacefully on April, 26, 2020 at the age of 96. He was born to Elizabeth and Eddie Schroeder in Needville, Texas. He attended school in Needville and graduated from Richmond High School in 1943. He served in the U.S. Army's Infantry 75th Division from 1943 to 1946 to the rank of First Sergeant. He received the French Legion of Honor medal in June 2019 for his WWII military service, thus designating him as a Knight of France. He attended the University of Houston until love struck and he married Alice. He worked for Central Freight Lines in Houston for 44 years as a dock worker, billing clerk, office manager and for many years as terminal manager, retiring in 1990. He served on Central's Board of Directors from 1970-1990. He retired to Franklin, Texas, where he was a member of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church.

He is survived by his wife of 72 years, his children Don, Dianne, Kathy, Garret, Sue and Steve, 9 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren, his 2 sisters and numerous nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his parents and his brother.

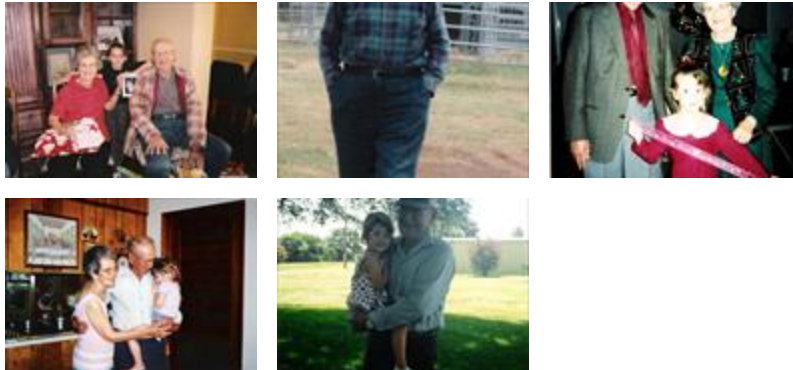

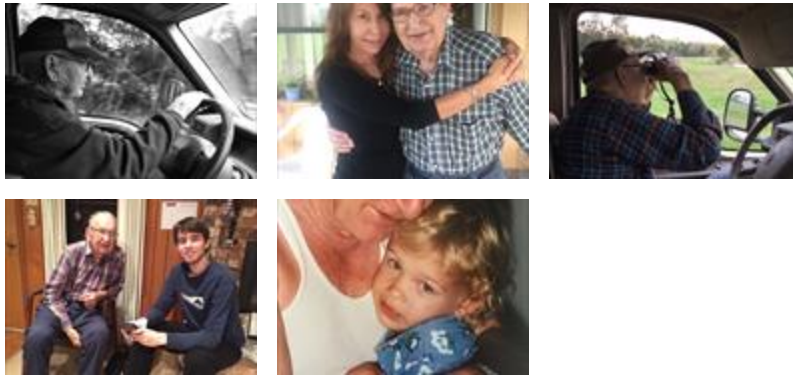
