



## Leon J. Brandt

March 13, 1934 - September 1, 2008

Funeral services for Leon J. Brandt, 74 of Richmond will be held at 11:30 A.M., Friday, September 5, 2008 in the Chapel of Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Home with interment following at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg. Reverend Larry Butcher will officiate the services.
