



## Leon Chernosky

February 27, 1925 - March 31, 2015

Leon Chernosky, 90, of Sugar Land, passed away March 31, 2015, at St. Luke's Episcopal Hospital in Sugar Land.

He was born in Sugar Land, Texas on February 27, 1925, to parents, Will and Clara Granoski Chernosky. He married Helen Maureen Lewis on September 3, 1949.

Leon proudly served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was awarded the EAME Campaign Medal with four bronze stars, the Good Conduct Medal, the World War II Victory Medal and received an honorable discharge with the rank of Technician 5th Grade. He was a current member of V.F.W. Post #4010. As a heavy equipment operator, he retired from the County of Fort Bend on June 30, 1990 with over 40 years of employment.
