A funeral mass for Leonard F. Orsak, 77, of Rosenberg will be held at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, March 10, 2011 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg with Fr. William D. Bartniski officiating. Interment, with full military honors, will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
