Leslie was born on December 29, 1927 in Schulenburg, Texas to Phillip and Emma Beiersdorfer. He went to Heaven on Friday, May 26, 2017. He was the youngest of 10 children.

In 1946, at the age of 18 years, he enlisted in the Army-Air Force. He was stationed in El Paso and the State of Colorado. He was honorably discharged in 1947. A few months after coming home, he met the love of his life, Mary (Marie) Knezek, of Ammansville. They were married on Monday, June 20, 1949 at Saint John the Baptist Church in Ammansville.

After their marriage, they lived in La Grange and later moved to Rosenberg to be near family and a good job.

They welcomed 2 daughters – Diana Marie and Dolores Ann.

Leslie worked for Schult Equipment as a farm mechanic; for Borden Milk Company as a delivery driver and then took a position as a beer salesman and delivery driver for Pearl Beer. He retired from Pearl Beer after 27 years of service.

Leslie was a loving, hard-working husband and father. He took good care of all 3 of his girls. He was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church for over 67 years. He served as an usher and would work at the Bazaar every August, in the Bar-B-Q pit area.

After retiring, he was a loving and caring caregiver to his wife – Marie. He was at her bedside when she went home to Heaven in September, 1998.

Dad loved his Texans. During football season you could always find him in his favorite chair, waiting for the game to begin, with his cigar in hand.

He was preceded in death by his wife – Marie, parents, brothers – Bill, Herbert, Walter Oswald, Ernest and his sisters – Amanda, Hilda and Linda.
