March 24, 1928 - February 18, 2019

Lillie Evelyn Polansky (Lil/Memaw), long-time resident of Richmond, Texas, passed away on Monday, February 18th, 2019 at the age of 90 from complications of her year-long battle with Congestive Heart Failure, leaving a huge void in the hearts of many. 90 years are a lot of years, but for someone as special as Lil, it wasn't enough.

Lil was born on March 24th, 1928 to Frank and Fannie Bravenec. In those days, the doctor went to the farms to deliver babies, so Frank and Fannie's first born, Lillie, was delivered by the country doctor on their farm in the Chriesman Community of Burleson County. The eldest of three beautiful girls, Lil had a twinkle in her eyes like her daddy and the biggest most adorable dimples like her mom.

While working in the Caldwell bank, those dimples caught the eye of a local boy, Milton Lewis Polansky, who continued to woo and revere Lil for all of their 68 wedded years together. To describe Lil as a homemaker is an understatement. Lil was the closest you'll get to a real life "June Cleaver". She could throw together gourmet meals, bake pies from scratch, was a seamstress, all the while keeping her house so clean you could eat off the floor. She had a standing hair appointment every Friday and her hair was always perfectly coiffed, makeup and jewelry on.

Lil was a lady of tireless energy and was active in many organizations over the years including volunteering at Oak Bend (formerly Polly Ryan) Hospital for decades, the Pecan Grove Women's Club, and at Sacred Heart Catholic

Church (where she worshipped for more than 35 years) she was a Eucharistic Minister and a member of the Society of Saint Margaret Mary.

Lil had one of the most generous personalities this world has ever been blessed with. Generosity comes in many forms. Lil's generosity was in her selfless giving of herself to others without any expectation of reciprocation; the sheer joy she felt was enough. Whether friend or family, to simply know Lil was to be on the receiving end of her generous heart. And if you were one of her grandchildren, the sky was the limit- there was NOTHING Memaw wouldn't do for them.

Left to cherish Lil's memory are her beloved sisters Dorothy Mgebroff and Mary Ann Novosad, her treasured youngest son Roger Polansky and daughter-in-love Ellen, and her precious grandchildren Megan Polansky, Jake Polansky, and Steven Polansky & wife Rebecca and their baby Myles (Lil's first great-grandchild and the newest apple of her eye), and her much loved nieces and nephews, along with countless other relatives and dear friends. Lil was preceded in death by her parents, her adoring husband Milton Lewis Polansky whom she joined in Heaven in time to celebrate their 70th wedding anniversary together on 2/20/2019, their eldest son Marcus Ray Polansky D.D.S. and middle son Jeffrey Ware Polansky, brother's-in-law Earl Mgebroff M.D., Clifford Novosad, and Charles Polansky & wife Billie Ruth Polansky.
