Lorene Novosad, our beloved mother and grandmother, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her family, on November 2, 2010 at the age of 74.

Visitation will be from 4:00 P. M. to 8:00 P. M., with a Tribute at 6:30 P. M. and a Rosary at 7:00 P. M., on Sunday, November 7, 2010 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.
