



## Lucille Josephine Ferguson

September 28, 1925 - April 5, 2015

Lucille Josephine Ferguson died peacefully on Easter Day, April 5, 2015. She was born in Scappoose, Oregon to the late Frank V. and Marie A. Hlavinka on September 28, 1925. The family then moved to East Bernard, Texas when she was a small child, where she remained for most of her life. She loved the community and was very proud of her Czech heritage.
