Lupe Galvan, a beloved wife, mother, sister, aunt and grandmother, went on to meet her Lord and Savior on Thursday, Aug. 3, 2023, after passing away peacefully in her home in Richmond, Texas. She was 63.

Lupe was born in Richmond on Jan. 26, 1960, to Enrique and Juanita Arizpe, and, along with her twin sister Mary, was the youngest of eight children.
