January 23, 1925 - August 11, 2015

Lydia Marie Mahlmann, 90, of Rosenberg, passed away on August 11, 2015 at Oak Bend Hospital in Richmond. She was born on January 23, 1925 in Beaumont to Carl and Emma Turicchi and was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg. Lydia loved her husband of 64 years, Arthur, and her six children. She loved to dance, sing at church, and cook. She was also a very active member of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas, the Altar Society at Holy Rosary, the K.J.Z.T., and the American Legion Auxiliary. Lydia loved to travel and one of her most memorable trips was to the Holy Land in 1985 with the Knights and Ladies of the Holy Sepulcher, a group dedicated to fostering education in the Holy Land.
