She decided to retire in 2013 at the age of eighty-three, moved in with her youngest daughter and together they joined Theresian's Catholic Women's Prayer Community. Marie was deeply devoted to the Rosary, daily Mass and loved watching Mother Angelica and Hallmark movies.

Retirement also meant time to enjoy her four children, twelve grandchildren and twenty-four great-grandchildren that made her legacy. She enjoyed her "mini get-aways" by spending time with each family and enjoying her newfound freedom.

Sadly, in 2018 Marie's health began to decline after she sustained a serious fall.

Throughout many complications and health challenges, she put up a courageous fight to manage each day the best she could.

On November 18, 2022 Marie left her loving family to enter into the Kingdom of Heaven, reunited with God, and all our loved ones she has dearly missed. She left a legacy for us all, with her compassionate, loving, caring, kind, adventurous, witty, intelligent, generous heart.
