She was the fourth of ten children. Growing up she helped her parents work the farm and watched her younger siblings.

On a blind date, October 31, 1944, Marion met the love of her life. When he returned home from the war, Carl Eastwood asked Marion to marry him. On December 12, 1946, they were married and started a journey that would last for 66 years. They bought their first home in San Juan and Marion was a stay at home mom. They had six children – Robert, Carl Jr (Milton), Virginia (Ginger), Mary, Linda, and James (Jimmy). In 1968, Marion and family settled in Rosenberg where they started their own business Carl Eastwood and Sons and with Marion's support, the company was a success.

Marion was not devoted to any certain organization, but a woman devoted to her faith, husband of 66 years; mom to five; grandmother to 8, great-grandmother to 11 and great-great grandmother to two. Her devotion to her faith was membership at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg.

Marion was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Carl Eastwood; her parents Elmer and Anna Kochert, brothers Gerald, Carroll, Jimmy and wife Irene, and Robert; sisters Crystal and Betty Kochert; her son Robert and daughter Ginger Pawlak .
