Maxine "Punky" L. (Johnson) Seiler, 69, of Richmond, Texas passed away on February 28, 2017 in Richmond. She was born August 25, 1947 in Little Rock, Arkansas to Ralph and Maxine (Hancock) Johnson. Maxine was a social worker that spent her life advocating for women and children. Before starting her own non-profit adoption agency, Maxine worked as a social worker for the Richmond State School. In 2001 Maxine and her dear friend, Debbie Seiler, started Family to Family Adoptions, Inc. where they have since gone on to place over 400 children in their forever homes. Throughout her career Maxine fought for equal rights, stood up for women against domestic violence, and created countless families through adoption and foster care. In addition to her work, she also volunteered at the Fort Bend County Women's Center for many years. This loving mother, grandmother, sister, friend, and mentor will be dearly missed by all whose lives she touched.

Maxine is preceded in death by her parents. Survivors include her daughter, Jennifer Seiler; grandchildren, Lauren & Nicholas Seiler; brother, John Johnson and wife, Danette; nephew, Kevin Johnson; nephew, Stephen Johnson and wife, Loren and their children, Adleigh and Aidan Johnson; along with numerous extended family and friends.

A memorial service celebrating Maxine's life will be held at 3:00 PM, at

Calvary Episcopal Church in Richmond, Texas on Sunday, March 5, 2017.
