



Melvin G. Herring

January 7, 1933 - May 14, 2011

Funeral services for Melvin "Mel" G. Herring, 78, of Houston, Texas will be held at 11 a.m., Friday, May 20, 2011 at Fishers of Men Lutheran Church in Sugar Land. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg. Pastors Jerry McNamara and Dr. Bill Dasch will officiate the services.

Visitation will be from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m., Thursday, May 19, 2011 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Mel was born January 7, 1933 in Haskell to Tullie and Clara Lamert Herring. He graduated from Austin in 1950, Concordia College, Winfield, Kansas in 1952, and Concordia Seminary, St. Louis in 1957. Mel served his vicarage for the president of the Kansas District, Missouri Synod. His ordination and installation at his first parish occurred August 4, 1957 at Lamesa, Texas, 1959. In 1961, he married Linda Gale Timian from Lubbock. Pastor Herring celebrated 50 years in the ministry in 2007. He passed away, May 14, 2011 in Temple.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Tullie and Clara Herring; and sister, Marilyn Parish.

Mel is survived by his loving wife of nearly 50 years, Linda; children, Leigh Gale Carreon and husband, Carlo, of the Woodlands, Mark Glyn Herring and

wife, Jacqueline, of Modesto, California, Sarah Beth Claburn and husband, Mark, of Mansfield, Texas and Rachel Ruth Brownlee and husband, John, of Lucas, Texas; brother, Jerry Wayne Herring and wife, Pat, of Amarillo, Texas; grandchildren, Megan, Emily, Elizabeth and Christian Carreon, Andrew and Alisha Segmiller, Jacob and Kathleen Claburn and Alexandra, Allison and Anna Brownlee; along with three nephews, one niece, other relatives and many friends.
