Michael Ross Newlin passed away July 4, 2012, at 10:00 PM. He loved fireworks and the sounds of the 4th surrounded him that evening.

Ross was born Sept. 13, 1964, in Richmond, Tx. He always had goals and plans and carried them through no matter how difficult or challenging. He loved cars, car racing and re-built several Mustangs with his son Michael and was working on an experimental electric vehicle with his daughter Renee.
