A funeral mass for Mildred Ann Myska Oberhoff, 80 of Needville will be held at 10:00 A.M. Wednesday, March 19, 2014 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Needville with Fr. Ramsey officiating. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
