



## Nancy L. (Krachala) Landry

April 15, 1944 - March 28, 2017

On Tuesday, March 28, 2017, Nancy Lee Landry, 72 of Needville, Texas, passed away, leaving behind countless stories and memories for her family and loved ones to cherish forever. She was born on April 15, 1944 in Sugar Land, Texas to Frank and Millie (Syblik) Krachala. Nancy graduated from Lamar High School in 1962. She soon met her husband, Don and started a family.
