Nancy Elizabeth Reese, 85, passed away September 13, 2022, in Sugar Land, TX surrounded by her family. Born in San Francisco, CA she was the daughter of Chester and Lillian Hahn. She attended San Jose State University where she met her husband William. She spent the next 30 years supporting her husband's distinguished Air Force career, which took them and their growing family to several different countries and numerous states before they retired in San Antonio, TX. Through all the moves and her husband's deployments she was the anchor of the family ensuring that every new house was a home and their children had what they needed to grow and succeed. She mentored student pilots' spouses and volunteered several hundred hours a year to support military families. She helped with the Head Start program, tutored elementary school students, worked with local law enforcement to improve community safety, and volunteered with the American Red Cross for over 30 years. She was a devoted Catholic serving the various parishes she attended throughout her life. She was a Lady in the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. Her efforts were regularly recognized by those she helped. She was a true hero to her family and to her community.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 59 years, William Reese and her sister Lee Rutherford.
