



## Norman Ross Short

Norman Ross Short, age 85, of Rosenberg, Tx passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 19th, 2026.

On August 18, 1940, he was born at home in Reagan, Tx. to Charlie Ross Short and Bernice Fuller Short.

He grew up in Reagan, Tx. and graduated from Marlin High School. He attended business school in Port Arthur and was a co-manager at Duke and Ayres in Rosenberg where he met his wife, Josephine.

loved listening to music and could play the guitar and later in life started learning how to play the keyboard. He also loved to research his family tree and spent lots of time on ancestry.com.

Norman was a faithful part of Grace Community Bible Church and a faithful attendee until his health prevented him from attending. However, he continued to listen to church services online. He trusted in Jesus Christ as His Savior and was confident that he was going to heaven when he left this earth.
