



## Norris Pressley Boynton

January 26, 1938 - February 13, 2021

Norris, "Tooter", Pressley Boynton, 83, of Magnolia, Texas, entered the Kingdom of Heaven, Saturday, February 13, 2021. Norris was born January 26, 1938, to Bernice Dan Teutsch and Robert Register Boynton, Sr., in Lufkin, Texas.

Norris grew up in Lufkin, Texas, a football athlete for the Panthers. He served in the United States Air Force from 1959 to 1963 during SAC, was honorably discharged and returned home to Lufkin to raise his three daughters and begin studies at Lamar University. Norris became a private aircraft pilot and flight instructor. He also used his skills from the military as a radio specialist to become an electronic computer hardware salesman, progressing to management of the sales force for the southeastern U.S., from which he retired.

Norris loved his family and friends. He started the first Boynton Family Reunions and "fish fries". For enjoyment, he loved going to the deer lease, hunting, and fishing. His faithful yellow Labrador, Boz, took every footstep with him there as well.

Norris, a great storyteller, an avid historian of Texas History and the Bible, was
