Owen Otto Borchardt, 81, of Damon, passed away peacefully at his home on April 16, 2019. He was born in Harlingen on March 14,, 1938.

After his high school graduation from Harlingen High School in 1956, Owen enlisted in the US Army where he served 2 years active duty and 4 years inactive duty. In 1959 he came to Damon to visit an army friend and met his future wife on a blind date. Following their marriage on November 5, 1960, Owen made Damon his permanent home.
