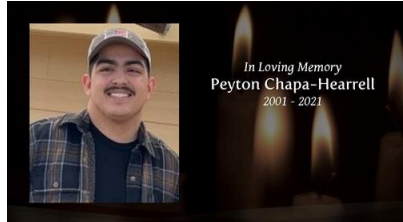

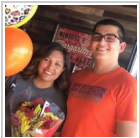
My son ran cross country with Peyton and remembers Peyton always being helpful and encouraging him. At the time, Peyton was a senior and my son was a freshman.

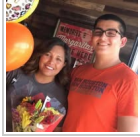

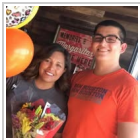
