



Price Curd Campbell, M.D.

February 25, 1925 - March 24, 2009

Dr. Price Curd Campbell, 84, passed away on March 24, 2009, in Richmond, Texas. He was born to Roy and Nell Campbell, February 25, 1925 in Davenport, Iowa. Price served in the U.S. Navy as a surgeon from February, 1943 to December, 1945 and was awarded an American Campaign Medal and World War II Victory Medal. Price received his undergraduate degree from the University of Louisville and graduated from Northwestern University Medical School in Illinois in 1950, specializing in Urology. Price practiced surgery and medicine for over 45 years, and was a life-time member of the Harris County Medical Society. Price served as Chief of Staff at Memorial Southeast Hospital as well as numerous other advisory positions.
