June 24, 1930 - March 16, 2025

Ralph Edward LeBoeuf, 94, of Richmond, Texas passed away on March 16, 2025. Ralph and his twin brother, Ronnie, were born to I.J. (“Jack”) and Nell Margaret (Canady) LeBoeuf on June 24, 1930 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was raised in Tulsa along with his five siblings. He honorably served our country, alongside Ronnie, in the United States Marine Corps from 1947-1950. After the Marine Corps, Ralph worked as an electrician on airplanes and became a sales representative for electronic manufacturers.

Ralph met the love of his life, Doris Lee Payne, on a blind date while she was in nursing school. They were married on October 3, 1953 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Ralph and Doris had two children, Allison and Paul, born in 1960 and 1962, respectively.

Ralph and Doris moved to Richardson, Texas in 1965 and raised their children there. They created a great community of life-long friends and were always the life of the party. Every summer Ralph would take his family to North Padre, Texas and his children will always cherish those memories.

Ralph and Doris ultimately moved to Richmond, Texas to be close to their daughter, Allison, and her family in 1992. They were incredibly involved grandparents and cherished time spent with their family. They would drive their grandchildren home from school and spend most weekends with the them. Ralph was known for his great sense of humor. When the children called out “Ralphie” he would always respond with “Yalphie!” He enjoyed woodworking and was a great teacher in his famous “Ralphie’s barn”. Ralph truly valued the time he could spend with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. In his later years, he loved to watch his seven great-grandchildren run around and engage them in conversation.

Doris was diagnosed and ultimately passed away from Alzheimer’s disease in 2007. Ralph sweetly and dutifully cared for Doris for over ten years. Even in the final years of her life, Ralph made sure to take Doris out and about to see family and eat at their favorite restaurants. Ralph took great pride in caring for his Doris and his family is forever grateful.
