Randal Don McGuire, 66, of Needville, entered into eternal rest on Monday, May 15, 2023.

Randal was born on December 15, 1956 to Verna Dell and Donald Eugene McGuire in Houston, Texas. After graduating from Needville High School in 1975, he went on to attend Wharton County Junior College. In 1976, he established and began operating McGuire Trucking, which he proudly owned and operated until his death.

Randal married Terry Horak on February 14, 1981 and recently celebrated 42 years of marriage. Before welcoming their two children, Katherine Rose and Michael Don, they enjoyed building their careers and traveling together.
