



## Raymond John Horelica, Sr.

September 1, 1930 - December 14, 2014

A funeral mass for Raymond J. Horelica, Sr., 84, of Rosenberg, will be held at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 16, 2014 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg with Fr. William D. Bartniski officiating. Interment with military honors will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
