



Raymond W. Leissner

January 6, 1917 - July 9, 2010

Raymond W. Leissner, 93, passed away on Friday, July 9, 2010 due to complications from a fall. Mr. Leissner was born on January 6, 1917, in Needville, Texas. He graduated from Rosenberg schools and went on to earn an Agriculture degree from Sam Houston Teacher's College now Sam Houston State University in 1939. After graduation, he worked in Velasco, Texas now Freeport and Pasadena, Texas, before returning to Needville in 1951. He lived in Needville for the remainder of his life. He was a respected rice farmer, cattle rancher, former Needville school board member, and real estate agent. He continued to raise cattle until the end of his life. He was a member of United Methodist Church in Needville and served actively in the church in his younger years.

Mr. Leissner was preceded in death by his parents Hamilton A. and Linda Schmidt Leissner, his siblings, Marvin Leissner and Lorene Browning Zeisemer, and his only daughter, Kathleen Leissner Whitman.

He is survived by his devoted wife, Florence, three sons, Nelson Leissner of Galveston, Ray Leissner and wife Sue of Dallas, and Adam Leissner and wife Kim of San Antonio, his step-children, Wesley Kaack of Needville, Carol Kaack Rychlik of Boling, and Lee Kaack and wife Beverly of Baytown. Mr. Leissner is also survived by 10 grandchildren, 15 great-grandchildren, several nieces, nephews and a host of friends.
