Reagan M. Walters, age 45, died December 14, 2014, in Houston, Texas. Reagan is survived by her husband, Brian Walters, of Sugar Land; her mother, Marilyn Rawson of Richmond; her father Robert Rawson of Llano; an uncle Archie Milam, cousins Alan and Adam Milam, nieces Allison and Bethany Faith, and godson Jonathan Monk. She is preceded in death by her grandparents Archie and Edwina Milam of Sugar Land, and O.J. "Hap" and Nellie Rawson of Rosenberg.

Reagan was born in May 18, 1969 in Houston. She was a 1987 graduate of Alief Elsik High School, and graduated from Stephen F. Austin State University in 1992. She had a long career in Houston's mortgage business, most recently as a Compliance Officer with Patriot Bank.

She married Brian in 1993.

Reagan was a social, active woman who was deeply involved with multiple service organizations. Some of Reagan's participation included: Wings Over Houston, the Susan G. Komen 3 Day, Relay for Life of Sugar Land, Exchange Club of Sugar Land and Santa's Exchange, Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo - Paint Horse Committee, and the Fort Bend Literacy Council.
