



Rodney Dale Steenbergh

February 2, 1953 - January 28, 2010

A memorial service for Rodney Dale Steenbergh, 56, of Rosenberg, Texas will be held at 2:00 p.m., Monday, February 1, 2010 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Dale was born in Highland Park, Wayne County, Michigan to Rodney Clifford and Nancy Jane Steenbergh on February 2, 1953. He passed away January 28, 2010 in Houston.

He is preceded in death by his parents; mother, Nancy Jane Taylor; and his father, Rodney Clifford Steenbergh.

Dale is survived by his loving wife Pamela Fairchild Steenbergh of 15 years; daughter, Jennifer Steenbergh; stepdaughter, Cynthia Pickard; and stepson, Andrew Pickard; along with other relatives and friends.

He began working at Baylor/National Oilwell Varco in 1991 as a machinist. After a fight with heart disease he was blessed with a heart transplant in 2005 and after only 2 months returned back to work in the quality control department until a sudden stroke in 2008. spending time with his family, friends and animals.

He will always be remembered for his sense of humor and his smile. He was quick to volunteer and help where needed, such as driving women to work from the abused women's center.
